The British Society for Proteome Research is pleased to announce that it will be offering two fellowships for Ph.D students and early-stage post-doctoral researchers to attend an intensive 5 day proteomics course. The course, the European Summer School "Proteomic Basics" that will take place in July 31 to August 6, 2011 in Kloster Neustift (Brixen/Bressanone, South Tirol, Italy)

The Summer School is a joint European Proteomics Association (EuPA; www.EuPA.org) and German Proteomics Society (DGP; <http://www.dgpf.org/dgpf-set.htm>)- training activity.

The course is taught by selection of internationally renowned proteomics researchers and will represent an excellent opportunity for young researchers to gain experience of Proteomics.
