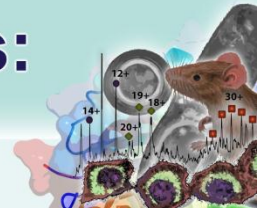

Late-breaking abstract submission guidelines

- Structure:** Introduction, results, conclusions
- Length of abstract:** 2,000 characters maximum (including blank spaces)
- Length of title:** 10 characters minimum, 200 characters maximum (including blank spaces). Titles must be written in CAPS.
- Disclosure of interest:** Please remember to disclose any areas of interest which may impact your abstract.
- Tables and Pictures:** Please do not include tables or pictures within your abstract.

Declaration text:

- I declare that any work with human or animal subjects related in this abstract complies with the guiding principles for experimental procedures as set forth in the Declaration of Helsinki and related publications.
- If my abstract is accepted for presentation at the congress, I also accept that the abstract may be published in a journal and might be made available at the congress.
- If the abstract is accepted as an oral presentation or poster, I therefore agree to present my abstract at the congress.
- I am aware that only abstracts from authors (or co-authors) who are actually presenting the poster at the conference will be published.
